Take medications with care. Follow the directions and ask your doctor or pharmacist about side effects and interactions.



Keep all medicines up & away. Place them out of reach of children and out of sight. Use a lock box or safe for extra security for the whole family.



Never share medicine prescribed for you. It may be dangerous for someone else.



Dispose of unused or expired medicines.
